A Gift of Chicks



"I have two children, my husband and his father are both ill and his mother in-law is paralyzed. Even if my husband could find work, his pay would not cover the medicine needs of my in-laws."

The pension for my husband parents the last few months has not been paid . My husband, he can't find a job, even if he finds one in the fields, it's really low pay and barely covers our food needs, and that's not talking about the medicine that we have to buy for his parents, or clothing for our children.

The chicken project that your organization introduced to us became a real help and survival for most of the families in our

village. We are getting approximately 80,000 Uzbek soum (\$80 USD) profit out of a two month cycle. For this money we are able to buy some medicine and some clothing and also I was saving some.

My wish is to start to sew dresses and clothes for the children to wear. If there was an opportunity for me to use a credit I would buy a sewing machine that has special features. Then people here wouldn't go to the city for buying these things. Also my wish is to teach some girls here who finished school and don't have any occupation, so they would be able to sew and tailor clothes for themselves and for others in the villages.
